Make sure you have completed the online enrollment for your child and have signed up for the screener using the Camp Learn-A-Lot link that was emailed to you. Following this event, elementary leaders will review readiness factors such as screener observations, birthdate, and parent input to make a placement recommendation in one of our early childhood programs. ZPS is committed to working with families to provide the smoothest possible transition to elementary school.
