DRESSING FOR THE WEATHER

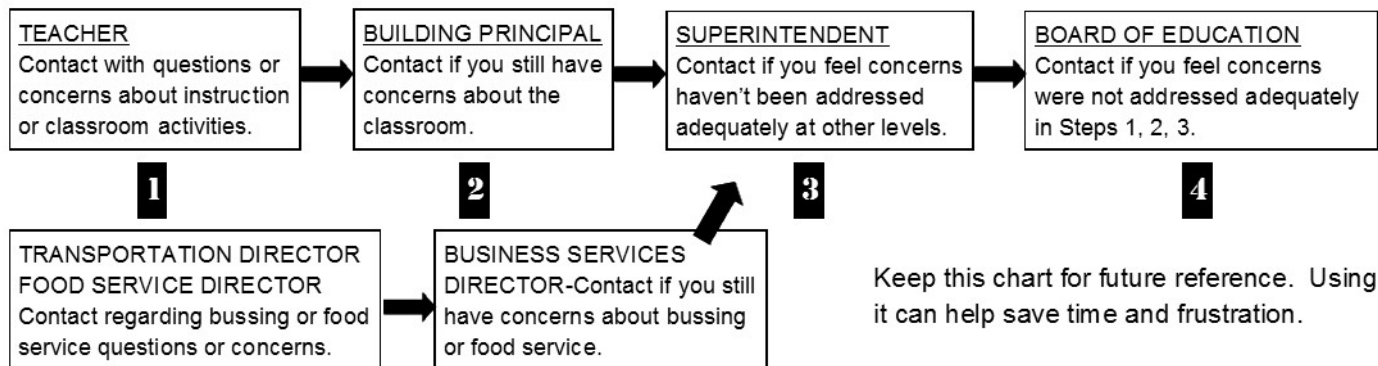
We all know that Michigan has very unpredictable weather. Please be sure your child is ready for the changes. Students will be outside for two recesses a day and they should be prepared with coats, hats and footwear that are appropriate.

- We do expect that children will go outside during recess periods, unless the temperature is an actual 10 or the wind chill is -10.
- Being dressed appropriately makes the recess periods a pleasant time to get some fresh air and “recharge the batteries” for another round of classroom learning.
- Our policy states that we believe it is very important that students have their outside recess time. There might be an unusual situation where a student needs to stay inside, but being outside does not cause illness.
- When considering a request to allow a student to stay in for health reasons, please consider whether your child should really be in school or not. It might be better to stay home to avoid spreading the illness to other students.
