
## Roller Skating in PE





## EMPOWER! Event & Bird Bowl September 26th; 4:45 & 7:00 PM



On Friday, September 26, the Zeeland East and West varsity football teams will meet on the football field in a highly anticipated matchup. Before the showdown, the Freshman and JV football players, along with each schools' cheerleaders, will come together with the zLinks program to run Zeeland Public Schools' annual EMPOWER! event for middle and high school students in the ZPS district who have a cognitive disability and/or an Autism Spectrum Disorder.

The event is offered to students with disabilities in 6th through 12th grade registered through the link provided below. Registered students will be partnered with a football player or cheerleader who will serve as their mentor/teammate for the event. Each participant will receive a jersey (if they don't already have one), participate in football drills, and have the opportunity to score a touchdown or join cheerleaders who will cheer on the players during the event.

Gates for the event open at 4:15 with a start time of 4:45. Tickets are \$5 and can be purchased online through GoFan. This includes entry to the varsity game.

Any high school student who attends the EMPOWER! game will get into the EMPOWER! and varsity game for free and will have pizza and drinks provided.

All proceeds will go to the zLinks program and their unified sports initiative.

## PERSONAL TECHNOLOGY Student Watches/Phones


