Halloween/Fall Parties at Lincoln

We do not have school on Halloween this year, so please connect with your child's teacher for details on classroom parties or festivities. Please see the costume guidelines below for all of Lincoln: Students will be able to wear their costumes for the entirety of the half day. Accessories to costumes that resemble weapons of any kind are not permitted at school. Student costumes should not display graphic images that suggest violence. Masks and face coverings will not be permitted. If for some reason students need to take off their costumes while at school, they should be able to get them back on independently. If you are signed up to help with a Halloween Party, please make sure you have done your 25/26 background check and bring your government issues ID/Driver's License to check in.

Attendance Information from the Office

The office will be sending home attendance information to individual families. This is informational at this time as we continue to monitor and ensure that our students are present at school and arrive to school on time. We will be doing these checkpoints throughout the year. One measure of success for students is being present at school. Late arrivals and early departures also affect their learning experience. Chronic absenteeism is considered when students miss 10% of school days (18 days per school year). As we move through the school year, our goal is to support and work alongside families.

We would like to offer your student the opportunity to participate in a program called "Hand2Hand". This program helps provide a student with food for the weekends and is intended for families who currently may be experiencing a financial burden.
