## **Spanish Immersion Families Newsletter**

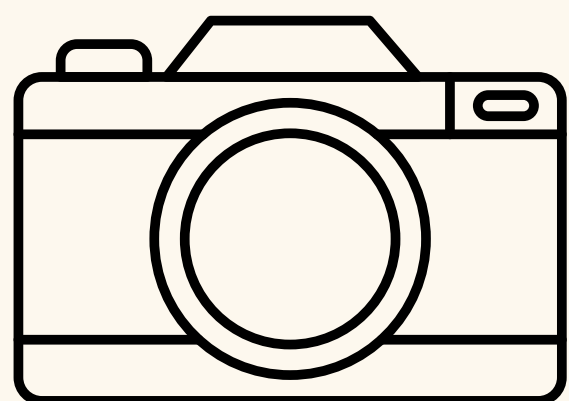
