# Pickleball Court Guidelines

#### **Scheduled Recreation Programs**

- 1. Scheduled activities include organized open play nights, township organized leagues, and lessons.
- 2. Recreation department programs have first priority to use of the courts during scheduled events.
- 3. Please be respectful of scheduled programs and activities and move off the courts 15 minutes prior to the start.

### **Organized Open Play Format**

- Games will be played to 11, winners stay and split, losers move off courts and put their paddle in the rack. If you win twice, move off the courts and put your paddle in the paddle rack - unless no one is waiting.
- 2. If more than 8 paddles are waiting, courts may move to a 4 on, 4 off rotation.
- 3. Challenge courts are accepted. Format is 2 on, 2 off. Get in line with a teammate to challenge the winners of the next court. Winning team stays on until it loses, or maximum 3 games when busy.







# Pickleball Court Guidelines

### **During Non-Scheduled Play**

- 1. All courts are available for public use.
- Private games during non-scheduled court time are acceptable, however holding a court is not.
- 3. If groups are waiting to play, rotation should follow 4 on, 4 off format at ALL times.
- 4. Games to 15 points are acceptable.
- 5. Please respect and adhere to all rules, be respectful of others, and have fun.
